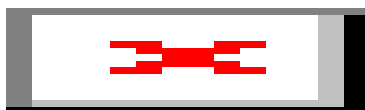

With reference to your email below, this Council does not adopt the practise of notifying individual GP surgeries/medical centres of receipt of planning applications. Rather, as agreed with the NHS, in response to any planning applications consisting of a development proposal of 20+ dwellings, Mr Malcolm Dicken, Head of Commercial Development and LPA Engagement who acts on behalf of NHS Somerset Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) is formally consulted and the NHS comments are invited accordingly. It is assumed by this Council that Mr Dicken or his colleagues will liaise directly with individual GP surgeries/medical centres, should he feel it necessary to do so, before providing any formal response to an application proposal on behalf of the NHS. As advised above, this means of consultation is as has been requested by and agreed with the NHS. I have copied the NHS into this email exchange should you wish to take this matter up with the NHS directly.

If you have looked at the Council's website in respect of this application, you will note that Mr Dicken has provided comments on 1<sup>st</sup> July. He has advised this Council that currently there is sufficient infrastructure capacity at the Queen Camel Medical Centre. He advises also that there may be operational issues to support the proposed care home so has forwarded the Council's email to the ICB to discuss this with the practise manager (presumably yourself?). The Council will leave it for Mr Dicken, the ICB and yourself to discuss any further matters directly and, should further comments be submitted, it is hoped that this will be on a co-ordinated basis.

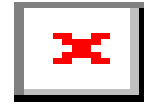
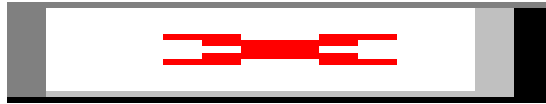
