The EPO has offered comments on 13th June. However, in response to the EA's comments and also continuing concerns raised by third parties that the Phase 2 Geo-environmental and Geotechnical Site Investigation has carried out inadequate testing of the site and also that the Council should serve an FOI request on DEFRA for information ascertaining to the site since the 1950's, the EHO has sought a second opinion from senior colleagues. That has not to date been forthcoming as the Environmental Protection team has been spending most of its resources and time dealing with the Glastonbury festival. Now that that event has finished, I am hoping for further environmental protection comments sooner rather than later.

Please find the Ground Investigation Report (doc ref. 1922554-R02(01)) prepared by RSK (May 2023) enclosed within the following link:

As discussed, Gleeson Land instructed RSK to undertake further ground investigations following concerns raised from local residents. The survey objectives are to identify any land contamination and/or geotechnical constraints of the site; and to identify the need for any additional investigation or remediation works.

In summary, the survey found that:

- Ground Model: no significant visual or olfactory evidence of soil contamination was observed during the course of intrusive investigation; and
- Geo-environmental Assessment: the site investigation and GQRA confirmed the absence of elevated contaminant concentrations within the soil profile across the site. It also found that the site is not located within an area that requires radon protective measures. Notwithstanding this, the report recommends that vigilance should be maintained during development for any undiscovered adverse ground conditions. A watching brief should be implemented during any development works at the site, with a strategy to address any unforeseen ground conditions that may affect the identifies sensitive receptors.

We also refer to a residents' concerns with regard to the grid positioning used, as you'll see from the enclosed, the site investigation report includes an investigation strategy and methodology section containing objectives, selection of investigation methods and the adopted investigation strategy

(targeted and non-targeted boreholes and trial pits). Appendix A (page 97) provides a detailed overview and justification of the process which should provide clarification sought by the resident.

I hope and trust the above and enclosed provide further clarification surrounding the ground conditions of the site however, please do let me know should you have any queries.
