

However on inspection and actual testing by Forge Environmental in consultation with PHE, the dark soil did not turn out to be a burial pit but darkened soil from buried and rusting metal. MPC are concerned that in both the email from Marc Dorfman on 11 June and the Environmental Health Memo to Marc Dorfman from Paul Huntington, it is stated that burial sites have not been found.

MPC were at the meeting on 23 October where the AMG consultants indicated that a suspected burial pit had been found. Black material indicating burning was mentioned and pictures were shown.

We are concerned that the presence of the suspected burial pit has been somehow forgotten, despite what we all heard at the meeting.

Perhaps it is because the documents from AMG do not set things out clearly.

Once you have looked into it, please let us know whether you now agree that there is a suspected burial pit at the site.

MPC are also concerned regarding the removal of suspected topsoil, How would this soil be collected and where would it be transported /deposited, surely not Mudford or surrounding villages?
